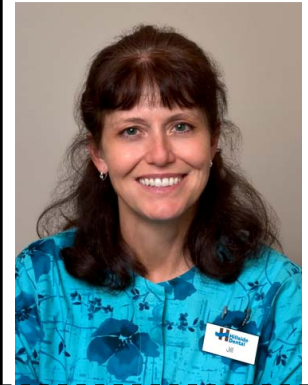

Should my Child have Sealants?

We recommend sealants for children's 1st and 2nd molars. This equates to about ages 6 and 12. Sealants are a plastic coating that bonds in the deep grooves on the biting side of back teeth. They are used to help prevent decay on that part of the tooth. Sealants can be placed on baby or permanent teeth. Fortunately, we are finding that most children do not need sealants on their baby teeth. Placing sealants is a simple procedure that does not require anesthesia. Sealants last several years, but do occasionally need to be "touched up".

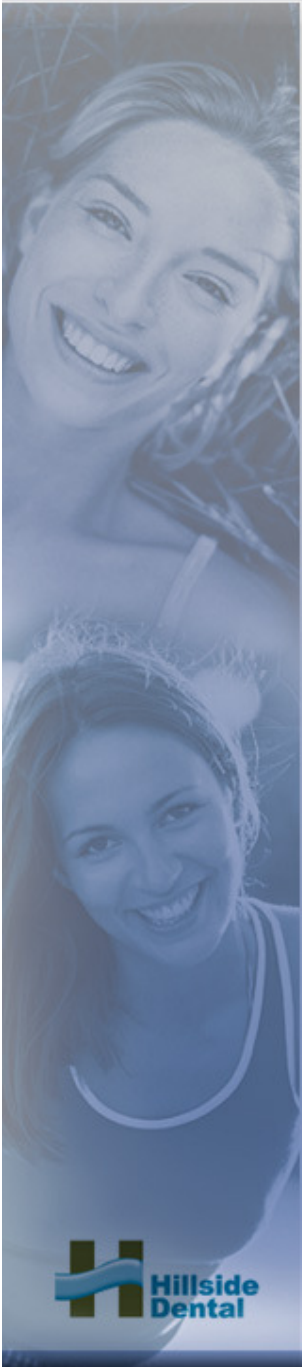
